Objectives

- 1.a. Fund grants through established application process
- 1.b. Advocate safety as it relates to bicycling
- 1.c. Recognize the achievements of individual programs that meet/fulfill NBAB's mission

Goal 2. Advise appropriate agencies on policies, plans, programs and facilities for safe use of bicycles

Objectives

- 2.a. Coordinate with agencies to integrate bicycle programs statewide
- 2.b. Review and provide input and advice on local and regional bicycle plan as needed
- 2.c. Annually review and provide input in the State Bicycle Plan.
- 2.d. Monitor, evaluate and/or recommend bicycling legislation

Goal 3. Disseminate information of/on trends and conditions on safe use of bicycles

Objectives

- 3.a. Review data (i.e., NCATS/NDOT) and identify trends.
- 3.b. Tasks:
 - i. Identify data fields to include in regular report
 - ii. Produce standard reports for NBAB meetings
- 3.c. Use reports to provide advice and recommendations
- 3.d. Create 1-page report card bulleting trends

Goal 4. Increase visibility and accountability of NBAB

Objectives

- 4.a. Annual report on NBAB activities and results
- 4.b. Annual review of effectiveness to determine strategies and actions of the board
- 4.c. Monitor and support content development for website BicycleNevada.com
- 4.d. Develop, coordinate and conduct annual bicycle pedestrian conference
- 4.e. Distribute annual trends fact sheet and NBAB Report to media in order to promote awareness
